

## Anaesthetist – Auckland – New Zealand

### Location:

The city of Auckland is located in the northern part of the North Island of New Zealand. It is one of the most densely populated areas in the country with about 500,000 inhabitants. The city is surrounded by many wine regions, beautiful beaches, pristine rain forests and the Hauraki Gulf. Auckland has a mild maritime climate with temperatures fluctuating between 11 degrees in the winter and 20 degrees in the summer. With over 2000 sunhours per year, Auckland is one of the sunniest areas in New Zealand. Auckland was recently rated as the third best place to live in the world.

The hospital operates from two sites: one is a 1000+ bed hospital with 14 operating theatres and the other is a surgical centre, with an elective surgical unit of 78 beds, 10 operating theatres and an anaesthesia-led perioperative care unit. The first site has one of the busiest acute surgical units in Australasia, requiring specialist cover on-site in the evenings and weekends to support 5 fellows and 23 anaesthesia registrars. It provides approximately 32,000 anaesthetic episodes per year for all surgical services except cardiothoracic and neurosurgery. Both adult and paediatric surgery is performed and the hospital has a busy obstetric unit.

### Job Description:

On behalf of a hospital in Auckland New Zealand, we are looking for an anaesthetist for a fulltime, permanent position.

The successful candidate is required to participate in the acute out of hours and call back roster. Aside from the regular tasks, you will contribute to the education, guidance and supervision of registrars, interns, medical students and other medical personnel. Moreover, you will be working in both acute as elective settings. The anaesthetist plays a central role in the function of the team. A lead role is expected in regard to developing, implementing and reviewing systems for assessment and for the delivery of care.

You must possess excellent leadership, communicational, social, management and administrative skills for this position. Furthermore, you must be able to work effectively and efficiently in a team and be experienced in your profession. Candidates with an interest in Acute Pain and/or Chronic Pain Management would be considered favourably.

In addition to attractive primary and secondary employment conditions, the employer offers support with the relocation to New Zealand.
