

## Anaesthetist – Auckland – New Zealand

### Location:

The city of Auckland is located in the northern part of the North Island of New Zealand. It is one of the most densely populated areas in the country with about 500,000 inhabitants. The city is surrounded by many wine regions, beautiful beaches, pristine rain forests and the Hauraki Gulf. Auckland has a mild maritime climate with temperatures fluctuating between 11 degrees in the winter and 20 degrees in the summer. With over 2000 sun hours per year, Auckland is one of the sunniest areas in New Zealand. Auckland was recently rated as the third best place to live in the world.

The concerning hospital covers a population of around 512.000 people from the Auckland, Waikato and Hauraki regions. This hospital is connected to a surgical centre nearby. Furthermore, this hospital operates with 1000+ beds and 14 operating theatres. The surgical centre operates with 78 beds and 10 operating theatres. Moreover, this surgical centre has a post-operative team led by anaesthetists. The Anaesthesiology department of this centre carries out around 32.000 services annually. The complete Anaesthesiology spectrum is treated here with the exception of neurosurgery and cardio-thoracic surgery. In the main hospital the Anaesthesiology department is supported by anaesthetists, 7 fellows and 23 Anaesthesiology registrars.

### Job Description:

On behalf of a hospital in New Zealand, we are looking for an anaesthetist with a special interest in post-anaesthesia care and pain medicine for either a full-time or part-time function. The full-time position is preferred.

The successful candidate will work a minimum of 4 sessions per week. One session consists out of 5 hours. Furthermore, there will be half day surgical sessions. These half day sessions count as one regular session. There is moreover, a minimum of 5 on-call sessions per week. The on-call roster consists out of a mix of required after hours-attendance in the hospital and being available for call back in necessary. It is noteworthy to mention that you will be working in both above mentioned locations. Also, the successful candidate will contribute to not only the education and guidance of Anaesthesiology registrars but also interns and medical students. Aside from the clinical tasks you will be involved in the development of the services provided and the improvement of afore mentioned services. Lastly, you will be involved in the recruitment and orientation of new applicants.

Candidates need to possess excellent communicational, educational, leadership and social skills.

The employer offers attractive employment conditions including a relocation package.
